She in preceded in death by her parents, Robert and Frances Stubblefield.

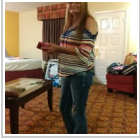
Surviving are her brother, Robert Stubblefield and wife Chrystal of Johnson City; and children, Kaitlyn Leann and Susan Louise.

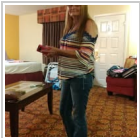

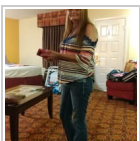
