Thomas McCracken, born on April 22, 1937, age 77, of Kingsport, passed away on Monday, May 5, 2014 at his home. He was born in St. Charles, VA and lived in Pennington Gap, VA before moving to Kingsport, TN. He was of the Assembly of God faith and served in the U.S. Navy. He was retired from General Dynamics in Warren, Michigan where he served as a welder from 1979-1993, building army tanks.
